SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION GUIDELINES

The Minnesota Association of Student Councils will award two scholarships annually. The following guidelines will be followed in making the selection of the scholarship recipient.

- 1) Student representatives on the State Executive Committee are eligible to be applicants for this scholarship. This would include the President, Vice-President, Secretary and Convention Coordinator.
- 2) Applicants will be considered on the basis of the following:
 - Exemplifies LEADERSHIP IN STUDENT COUNCIL, SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY.
 - Contributes significantly to the success of applicant's local school and community.
- 3) Only one applicant is eligible per school. The same applicant <u>CAN NOT</u> apply for the MASC Scholarship. The applicant must have at least 2 years of membership on student council.
- 4) The scholarship money will be forwarded directly to the institution of the winner's choice and will be awarded upon the successful completion of the first quarter/semester of attendance at that institution.
- 5) Recipients of the scholarship will be notified prior to the MAHS/MASC State Leadership Convention and must attend the convention banquet on April 14, 2024.
- 6) The selection of the scholarship recipient will be made prior to the MASC/MAHS State Leadership Convention.
