The recipients of this scholarship are students who excel in the areas of service and leadership, contributed significantly to the success of their local school and community. These students should be exemplarily role models in their communities and schools.

The Ardis Kyker Leadership Scholarship was created to honor Ardis Kyker who had been the Student Councils' Coordinator of Professional Activities in the State of Minnesota from 1983-2001. She had been very instrumental in the development of Student Council and its successes in the state and the national level. She had taken Minnesota to the forefront of Student Councils nationwide.

Enclosed is an application form to be completed by your council's candidate. (ONLY ONE APPLICANT PER COUNCIL.) This form along with three letters of recommendation and the candidate's personal letter must be postmarked by January 27, 2017. The winners will be announced at the MAHS/MASC State Leadership Convention.

RECIPIENTS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP WILL BE NOTIFIED PRIOR TO THE CONVENTION AND MUST ATTEND THE CONVENTION BANQUET ON APRIL 23, 2017 AT THE ROCHESTER INTERNATIONAL EVENT CENTER TO RECEIVE THEIR SCHOLARSHIP.

SCHOOLS MUST BE MEMBERS OF THE MASC AND MASCA.

The scholarship money, provided through the Minnesota Association of Student Council Advisors, will be forwarded directly to the institution of the winner's choice and will be awarded upon the successful completion of the first quarter/semester of attendance at that institution.

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION GUIDELINES

The Minnesota Association of Student Council Advisors will award two scholarships annually. The following guidelines will be followed in making the selection of the scholarship recipient.

- 1) Student representatives on the State Executive Committee are eligible to be applicants for this scholarship. This would include the President, Vice-President, Secretary and Convention Coordinator.
- 2) Applicants will be considered on the basis of the following:
Exemplifies LEADERSHIP IN STUDENT COUNCIL, SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY.
Contributes significantly to the success of applicant's local school and community.
- 3) **Only one applicant is eligible per school.** The same applicant **CAN NOT** apply for the MASC Scholarship. The applicant must have at least 2 years of membership on student council.
- 4) The scholarship money will be forwarded directly to the institution of the winner's choice and will be awarded upon the successful completion of the first quarter/semester of attendance at that institution.
- 5) Recipients of the scholarship will be notified prior to the convention and must attend the convention banquet on April 23, 2017 at the Rochester International Event Center
.
- 6) The selection of the scholarship recipient will be made by Ardis Kyker prior to the MASC/MAHS State Leadership Convention.
