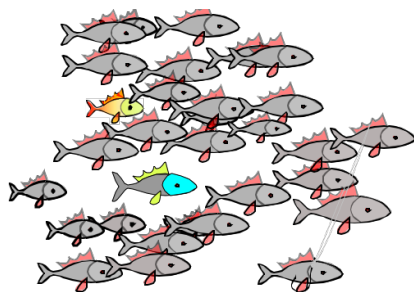

**10:30 a.m. Student Presentations:** Your school will have the opportunity to present your school’s “Best Practice” idea. Come with handouts and be ready to share.

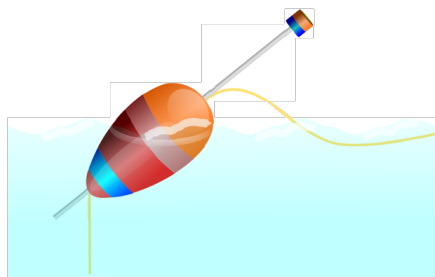
**11:45 a.m. Lunch will be provided**
